Letter to schools: Approved and James will get out

Press release: All modifications to John by 18.00 on Tuesday 21st March; John will get out. Hannah to get signing up facility back onto website before it goes out.

Neighbourhood plans: Lyn reported on Locality conference. A neighbourhood Plan is a big commitment but we at least want to go for it, linking informally with Poppleton, Micklegate and any initiatives in Westfield and Acomb. Lyn to keep holding brief.
